



Mystery Monday #6

What you need~
½ yd for outer border

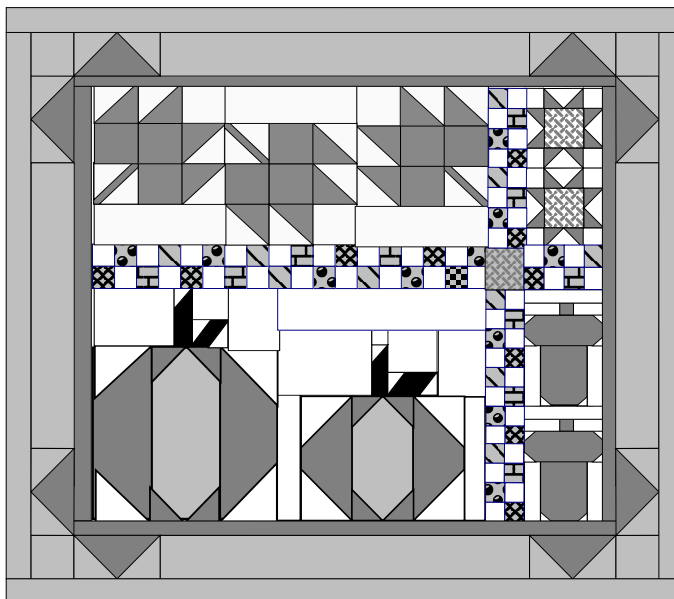
Let's begin~

- *Stitch 2 ½" X 16 ½" outer border strip together with (2) flying geese units. Press. Make 2.
- *Stitch pieced border to sides of wall hanging. Press.
- *Stitch 2 ½" X 18 ½" outer border strip together with (2) flying geese units and (2) 2 ½" outer border square.. Press. Make 2.
- *Stitch pieced border to top and bottom of wall hanging. Press.
- *Stitch 1 ½" X 28 ½" outer border strip to sides of wall hanging. Press.
- *Stitch 1 ½" X 32 ½" outer border strip to top and bottom of wall hanging. Press.
- *You are all done with Mystery #6!
- *Layer with batting and backing, quilt and bind as desired.

Cutting~

From outer border fabric ~

- *Cut (2) 2 ½" X 18 ½" rectangles. (top and bottom border).
- *Cut (2) 2 ½" X 16 ½" rectangles. (Sides)
- *Cut (4) 2 ½" squares.
- *Cut (2) 1 ½" X 28 ½" strip. (Sides)
- *Cut (2) 1 ½" X 32 ½" strips. (Top and bottom)
